Expectations on Behaviour

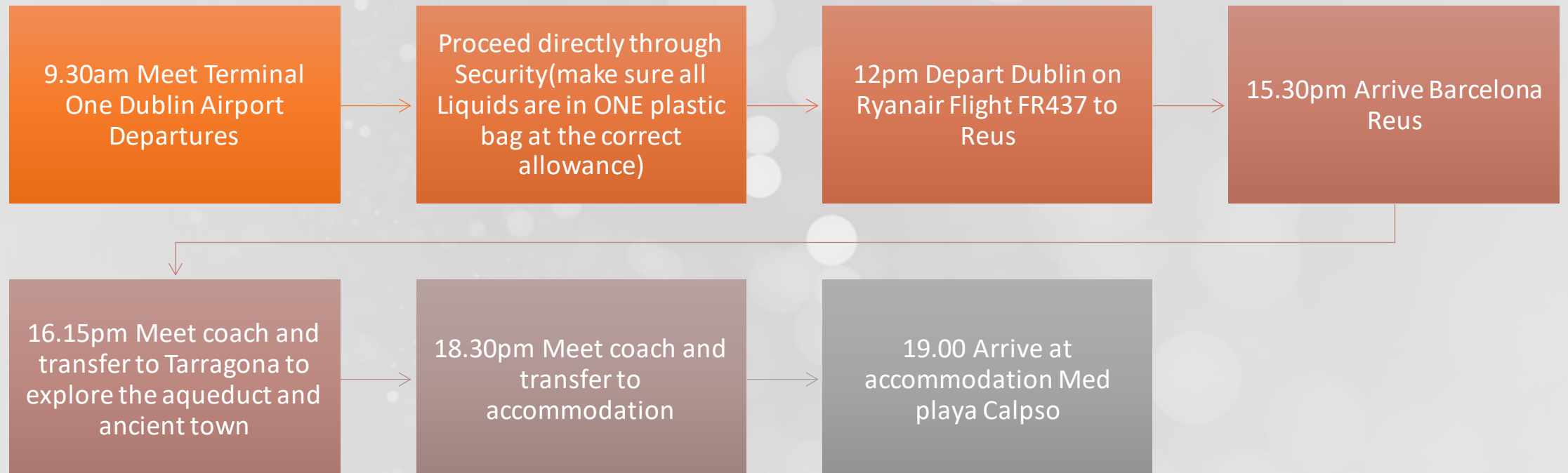
- Full school rules apply

Continued

- **If a student's Behaviour becomes too disruptive, i.e. Serious incident The parent will be required to fly over to collect their son or daughter to take them home at their own expense**
- Any damage to the property will be at the expense to the student, not the school
- Students are not permitted to leave the hotel without a member of staff for any reason
- Students are not permitted to leave the group under any circumstances unless clearly instructed on free time guidelines
- Serious incidents will be referred to the Board of Management if necessary

Things to Note
